Temporary Food License Holders Reminders

Dear Temporary Food License Holders:

Please review and be familiar with the requirements set forth in the health code (Chapter 24) that will be used for Health Inspections. You may view the code at:

A hard copy is available from the Town of Morristown Health Division at a charge of \$15.00.

In addition, please adhere to the following:

- Proper hand washing & sanitizing methods on site.
- Those handling/preparing foods must have water, soap and paper towels. When dealing with meat, poultry, fish or other hazardous foods, facilities must have a water jug with faucet for dispensing water. In addition, a container to catch running water must be available. Used water must be collected and removed (Not to be dumped on the ground) by the vendor.
- All others are to have hand sanitizer for hand washing.
- All Vendors are to have sanitizing wipes for cleaning food contact areas.
- Any food displayed or self-service is to be protected from external contaminations (covered).
- Gloves must be in use.
- Operator shall not handle food and money at the same time.
- Thermometers are to be on hand for checking food temperatures.
- All hazardous food is to remain within safe hot or cold temperature range as stated in the code.

Inspection will be executed and penalties assessed for failure to comply. If you have any further question please feel free to contact Division of Health.
