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ORDINANCE NO. O-13-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF MORRISTOWN CHAPTER 7 "TRAFFIC", SECTION 17 "RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING" TO LIMIT PARKING TO PERMIT AND STICKER PARKING AT ALL TIMES ON SECTIONS OF SCHUYLER AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Town of Morristown currently has an Ordinance that establishes restrictions on parking on certain residential streets within the Town of Morristown; and

WHEREAS, the Town Engineer for the Town of Morristown believes that it would be in the best interest of the Town to establish parking restrictions on portions of Schuyler Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Morristown, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, being the governing body thereof, that Chapter 7 Traffic, Section 17 Residential Permit Parking be and is hereby amended and supplemented to establish a new sub-section in 7-17.2 to provide that parking shall be limited at all times to permit and sticker parking on certain streets designated by the Town of Morristown as follows:

**7-17.2 Parking By Permit on Designated Residential Streets**

d. Parking shall be limited at all times for permit and sticker parking only on the streets designated in subsection 7-17.6(d) of this section.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, Chapter 7 Traffic, Section 17 Residential Permit Parking be and hereby is amended and supplemented to establish a new sub-section in 7-17.6 Schedule of Streets to provide that parking on portions on Schuyler Avenue shall be limited at all times to permit and sticker parking as follows:

**7-17.6 Schedule of Streets**

d. Parking shall be limited at all times for permit and sticker parking only on the following described streets or portions thereof in the Town of Morristown

Street	Location
Schuyler Avenue	North Side, from a point 102 feet west of the westerly curb line of Wetmore Avenue to the end of Schuyler Avenue
	South Side, from a point 134 feet west of the westerly curb line of Wetmore Avenue to the end of Schuyler Avenue

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with law.
